How To Detail A Car.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

- Vacuum cleaner
- Variety of rags
- Various sizes of small brushes
 - Plastic spray bottles

CONTINUED

- Canned air (used on computer keyboards)
 - Upholstery or leather cleaner
 - Carpet stain cleaner
- Surface protector for vinyl/leather surfaces

DETAILING THE INTERIOR

- **Carpetea-vacuume and remove stains**
 - **Upholstery-vacuum and remove stains**
 - **Door jams-clean metal and plastic**
 - **Door interiors-clean surfaces and crevices**
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CONTINUE

- **Inside windows- wipe clean, then dry.**
- **Steering wheel and column-dust, dry, and use surface protectors.**
 - **Dashboard-clean with small brushes.**
- **Center console- use detailing tools and a thick cloth.**

DETAILING THE EXTERIOR

- Start with the wheels-no detergent in solution
 - Change water and add car wash soap
- Wash are with clean rags and soapy solution
 - If a rag became dirty, use a clean one
- Use smaller brushes and tools around headlights
 - Rinse everything well with clean water

CONTINUED

- To dry the car use only a chamois or cotton cloth
 - Blow away standing water with a hair-dryer
 - Wax car
 - After the wax dries, wipe away a brush
- Use a newspaper to clean the windows and numbers

- This may like a lot of work, but it's a good idea to detail your car every few months. This will keep your car looking nice for many years.
